
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I. Fictitious flights: second lesson

i. Example

Todays airport is a fictitious airport. Its name is Auriol. Here's the diagram:



Different scenarios:

F-GSZP | TB20 - VFR

- > On ground at GA apron, with ATIS
- > Requesting taxi for a local flight via NE

N477EU | SR22 - VFR

- > Overhead NE, with ATIS
- > Requesting joining instructions

OO-PCJ | PC12 - VFR

- > 1 min before NW, with ATIS
- Requesting transit to SE

F-GLTZ | PA18 - VFR

- > On ground at GA apron, with ATIS
- > Requesting taxi for a local flight via NE

F-BVAV | Rallye - VFR

- > On ground at GA apron, with ATIS
- > Requesting taxi for a local flight via NE

F-GNXT | DR400 - VFR

- > Overhead NE back from local flight, with ATIS
- > Requesting joining instructions

N416PT | SR20 - VFR

- On ground at GA apron, with ATIS
- Requesting taxi for circuit patterns

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N871NR | Cessna centurion - VFR

- Overhead SE back from local flight, with ATIS
- > Requesting joining instructions

II. Autonomous work continuity
